

**Tiffinian Association Limited**  
**(“the Association”)**

**Classes of Membership**

The Board of Directors (Trustees) make these rules under articles 3.1 and 31 of the Articles of Association.

1. Members

- 1.1. Members are (in addition to the Directors for the time being) former pupils of Tiffin School who:
  - a) In the previous financial year paid a subscription fee or donation in such a sum as shall be determined by the Directors and advised at each AGM (minimum £10);
  - b) Declare that they are willing to assume the obligations of membership as defined by the Memorandum and Articles of Association, including to promise if the Association is dissolved while he or she is a member or within twelve months after he or she ceases to be a member, to contribute such sum not exceeding £10 as may be demanded of him or her towards the payment of the debts and liabilities of the Association incurred before he or she ceases to be a member, and of the costs charges and expenses of winding up, and the adjustment of the rights of the contributories among themselves; and
  - c) Apply to (using the requisite form as approved by the Directors) and are accepted by the Directors of the Association as Members.
- 1.2. In addition to the entitlements of Tiffin Friends Associate Members, Members have the rights and obligations of members set out in the Memorandum and Articles of Association, and therefore have the right to attend and vote at the general meetings of the Association (such as the Annual General Meeting).
- 1.3. For the avoidance of doubt, Tiffin Friends Associate Members who have not become Members under paragraph 1.1, nor Sports Associate Members, do not have the rights or obligations as members under the Memorandum and Articles of Association, and therefore do not have the right to attend and vote at the general meetings of the Association.

2. Tiffin Friends Associate Members

- 2.1. Tiffin Friends Associate Members are all former pupils, parents of current and former pupils, current and former staff and current and former governors of Tiffin School, together with any Honorary Members so designated by the Directors.
- 2.2. Tiffin Friends Associate Members are eligible to receive the electronic TiffNews publication, to participate in Old Tiffinian sporting teams, to use Old Tiffinian sporting and related social facilities at the discretion of the Association, and to attend Old Tiffinian events.

3. Sports Associate Members

- 3.1. Sports Associate Members are (i) participants in Old Tiffinian sports teams not eligible to be Tiffin Friends Associate Members, and (ii) members of invited external clubs visiting the facilities of the Association in order to participate in sporting activities.
- 3.2 Sports Associate Members are eligible to participate in the sporting and related social functions of the Association and to make use of such facilities operated by the Association at its discretion.

4. Licensing Act 2003 requirements

- 4.1. With respect to (i) Members, (ii) Tiffin Friends Associate Members, and (ii) Sports Associate Members who are participants in Old Tiffinian sports teams:
  - 4.1.1. no individual may be admitted to membership, or admitted to any privilege of membership, without an interval of at least two days between their nomination or application for membership or their admission; and
  - 4.1.2. any person becoming a member without prior nomination or application may not be admitted to the privileges of membership without an interval of at least two days between them becoming members and their admission.
- 4.2. With respect to Sports Associate Members who are members of external clubs visiting the facilities of the Association, no individual may be admitted to membership unless the rules of the external club comply with paragraph 4.1.
